Colts Cricket

Club policy is that parents or other responsible adults are responsible for transporting young players to and from all colts matches and practice sessions. Therefore, the Club will not be registering Private Vehicles for the transportation of young players in connection with any colts fixtures or practice sessions arranged by the Club.

The implementation of this policy is not intended to exclude any player from participation and parents or guardians should contact the Club Welfare Officer if they have any problems with the transportation of players to matches or practice sessions.

Adult Cricket

Subject to the Children Playing in Adult Cricket policy, young players may be selected to represent adult teams in away fixtures. At parental request and subject to the agreement of the Team Captain, the young player may then be included in any team transportation arrangements.

In this case, written parental permission will be required before the Team Captain, or other responsible adult appointed by the Team Captain, will be able to transport that young player too or from the away team ground.

Consent for this transportation will be collected via the Colts Membership Form.
